

Rule 5: Scoring and Timing Regulations

- 1) An untouched throw-in cannot score a goal?
- 2) A field goal cannot be scored when the clock is stopped?
- 3) If a player-control foul is called after the ball has passed through the goal, the basket counts and the foul is penalized?
- 4) Team A is assessed a Technical Foul to begin the second half. By mistake, the officials allow B1 to shoot the free throws into the same basket they played at in the first half. Ruling: Since the ball was shot into team A basket, the points count for team A?
- 5) Prior to the game, Team A is warming up at the East goal and Team B is warming up at the West goal. When the players come out for the opening jump ball, A1 lines up facing the West goal and B1 lines up facing the East goal. None of the officials notice the mistake. The ball is tossed and is caught by nonjumper A2. All players start up the court except A3. A2 passes the ball to A3 who turns and throws the ball into the East goal. Ruling: Score 2 points for team A.
- 6) The winning team is the team that scores the most points?
- 7) The score of a forfeited game is always 2-0?
- 8) 10 minutes prior to the game time, it is mandatory for each team to have their team members in the official score book with the player's numbers and the starting five designated?
- 9) Game playing time for varsity games is four (4) eight-minute quarters?
- 10) Halftime is 10 minutes in length unless the home management has notified the visiting team of an extended halftime. Halftime can be extended to a maximum of 12 minutes?
- 11) For sub-varsity level games halftime can be shortened to eight minutes?
- 12) The length of an overtime period is equal to half the length of a quarter in the game being played?
- 13) No penalty or part of a penalty carries over from one quarter to the next?
- 14) Free throws after time has expired will only be taken if they will affect the outcome of the game or if a state scoring record is a stake?
- 15) The fourth quarter ends with the score 58 - 58. The ball is tossed to start the first overtime period and A1 scores a three point basket. After the basket the scorer and timer signal the referee to come over to the table. The scorer tells the referee that she made a mistake and did not add a score by Team B to the total. The scorer indicates that Team B had really scored 60 points in regulation play. The referee reviews the book and sees that the scorer is correct. He then blows his whistle and indicates that the game is over and that Team B is the winner?
- 16) Time outs cannot be called prior to the start of the game or the start of overtime?
- 17) For 60 second time outs, conferences shall be within the confines of the team bench area. For thirty second time outs the players must remain standing?

Rule 6: Live Ball and Dead Ball

- 1) Once the referee is ready to toss the ball, nonjumpers cannot move onto the center circle?
- 2) Once the referee is ready to toss the ball, nonjumpers cannot move off the center circle?
- 3) The jumpers are required to jump and try to tap the tossed ball?
- 4) The jump ball ends when the ball touches the floor?
- 5) The jump ball ends when the ball touches a non-jumper?
- 6) The jump ball ends when the ball is caught by a jumper?
- 7) If a double personal foul is called, the team in possession at the time of the call will always retain possession of the ball?
- 8) The result of a thrown ball lodging between the basket and the backboard is an AP throw-in?
- 9) If team A is attempting an alternating possession throw in and a member of team A fouls a player for team B, team A will attempt the next alternating possession throw in?
- 10) If team A is attempting an alternating possession throw in and a member of team B fouls a player for team A, team A will attempt the next alternating possession throw in?
- 11) If team A is attempting an alternating possession throw in and a member of team A violates, team A will attempt the next alternating possession throw in?
- 12) A live ball becomes dead when a thrown ball enters and pass through the basket?
- 13) A live ball becomes dead when any free throw violation occurs?

Rule 7: Out of Bounds and the Throw-In

- 1) A player in possession of the ball is out of bounds when he touches anything, including another player, that is on the boundary line or outside of this line?
- 2) A ball that is thrown or bounces over a rectangular backboard is considered to be out of bounds?
- 3) A ball that rolls along the top end of a rectangular backboard is considered to be out of bounds?
- 4) The ball is caused to be out of bounds by the last player that touched the ball while it was in bounds?
- 5) A1 throws a pass to A2 and the ball strikes an official that is standing in A's front court. The ball rebounds back into A's back court where it is recovered by A3. Ruling: A's ball as the official is part of the court?
- 6) A1 throws a pass to A2 and the ball strikes an official that is standing with one foot in bounds and the other foot out of bounds. Ruling: A1 has caused the ball to go out of bounds?
- 7) For a designated spot throw-in, the thrower may back up as far as the court will allow?
- 8) If Team A is entitled to run the end line for a throw in and team B violates and the ball would next be put into play along this same end line, then Team A will still have the run of the end line?
- 9) If Team A is entitled to run the end line for a throw in and B2 fouls A2 near the same end line, Team A will not have the run of the end line?
- 10) If Team A is entitled to run the end line for a throw in and B2 fouls A2 near the division line, Team A will not have the run of the end line?
- 11) The resuming play procedure is in effect only after a time out or an intermission?
- 12) A1 fouls B1 and at the same time B3 fouls A3. Team A had control, so by rule, the ball will be awarded to A at the point of interruption. The throw in spot is a spot closest to the foul by B3?
- 13) The throw in starts when the ball is at the disposal of a player for the team entitled to the throw in?
- 14) The throw in ends when the ball is touched on the court by another player?

Rule 8: Free Throw

- 1) During a free throw, the first lane spaces shall be unoccupied?
- 2) During a free throw where lane spaces are to be occupied, the first lane spaces must be occupied by an opponent of the free thrower?
- 3) The administering official is to hand or toss the ball to the free thrower?
- 4) During a free throw where lane spaces are to be occupied, the last lane spaces may be occupied by an opponent of the free thrower?
- 5) During a free throw where lane spaces are to be occupied, there can be no more than six players along the free throw lane lines?
- 6) During a free throw where lane spaces are to be occupied, players may leave these marked lane spaces when the free throw shooter releases the ball on the attempt?
- 7) During a free throw where lane spaces are to be occupied, players that are not on the lane spaces must be behind the free throw line extended and behind the three point arc?
- 8) Once the ball is made live, free-thrower has 10 seconds to release the ball on an attempt?
- 9) A1 is on the free-throw line. B1 fakes going into the lane and A2 steps into the lane. Ruling: Ball becomes dead immediately. However, A1 will be given his entitled free throw and, if missed, will get a substitute free throw because of the violation by B1?
- 10) Any eligible team member may attempt a free throw that results from a technical foul?
- 11) A1 is driving to the basket and is fouled. A1 is injured on the play and is unable to attempt his free throws. Team A has three eligible players on the bench. Ruling: The coach or captain of Team B shall pick the player that they want to attempt A1's free throws?
- 12) After all technical free throws conclude, the ball will be put in play at the division line, table side?
- 13) After all intentional free throws have concluded, the ball will be put in play at the division line, opposite the table?
- 14) If a personal foul is followed by a technical foul, all free throws are taken with no players along the lane line?
- 15) Penalties for fouls are administered in the order that the fouls occurred?

Rule 9: Violations and Penalties

- 1) There are three types of violations and each carries its own penalty?
- 2) If a free thrower fakes a try it is a delayed violation?
- 3) If B1 disconcerts free thrower A1 and the free throw misses the ring, a substitute free throw is not awarded to A1 because this constitutes a double violation?
- 4) If B1 enters the lane early and A1, who is standing behind the three point line, then steps across the three point line before the free throw hits the backboard or ring, this is an example of a double violation and the ball will be awarded to the team entitled to it under the alternating possession procedure?
- 5) On a throw in, A1 sees that no teammate is open and throws the ball off B1 who is standing inbounds. The ball caroms back to A1 who has entered the court and he dribbles away. Ruling: Legal Play
- 6) On a throw in, A1 sees that no teammate is open and throws the ball off one of the officials that is standing inbounds. The ball caroms back to A1 who has entered the court and he dribbles away. Ruling: Legal Play
- 7) It is a throw in violation if A1 and A2 are both out of bounds on a designated-spot throw in?
- 8) It is a throw in violation if A1 and A2 are both out of bounds when team A is entitled to run the end line for a throw in?
- 9) Once the throw in begins, the thrower has five seconds to release the ball onto the court?
- 10) A1 is out of bounds for a throw-in. He sticks the ball through the plane and the ball is batted away by B1. Ruling: Technical foul on B1.
- 11) A1 is out of bounds for a throw in. A1 releases the ball from well off the court. B1 leaps from inside the court area and catches the pass while over the out of bounds side of the floor. Prior to returning to the floor B1 calls a time out? Ruling: Legal Play by B1.
- 12) A1 is dribbling up the court and steps on the boundary line. When she steps on the line she is not in contact with the ball. Ruling: Out of bounds violation on A1.
- 13) Kicking the ball is an intentional act. Kicking can occur on any part of the player's leg (foot)?
- 14) A1 has released the ball on a try for goal. The ball is in flight when A2 is charged with a violation for swinging the elbows. The ball enters the basket? Ruling: Count the goal by A1.
- 15) All violations cause the ball to become dead immediately?
- 16) All violations by Team A cause the ball to become dead immediately?
- 17) A1 throws a pass from his back court toward his front court. The ball is tipped by B1 who is standing in A's front court. The ball rebounds back to A1. Ruling: The ball gained front court status when touched by B1. Start a new 10 second count for Team A.
- 18) A1 throws a pass from his back court that is tipped by B1. B2 jumps from his front court and secures possession of the ball while in the air. B2 then lands in the back court. Ruling: Back court violation on B2?
- 19) A closely-guarded count shall not be started during an interrupted dribble?
- 20) The three second rule does not apply during an interrupted dribble?
- 21) There is team control during an interrupted dribble, thus it is allowable for a team to call time out during an interrupted dribble?

Rule 10: Fouls and Penalties

- 1) All fouls involve contact?
- 2) All personal fouls involve contact?
- 3) All personal fouls take place while the ball is alive?
- 4) All common fouls are personal fouls?
- 5) All technical fouls take place while the ball is dead?
- 6) The penalty for an intentional foul is two shots and the ball out of bounds at the division line, opposite?
- 7) The penalty for a flagrant foul is two shots and the ball out of bounds at the division line opposite and the player is ejected?
- 8) The penalty for a technical foul is two shots and the ball out of bounds at the division line, opposite?
- 9) The penalty for a player being out of bounds for an unauthorized reason is a technical foul?
- 10) For double fouls, there are no free throws and the ball is awarded to the team using the AP arrow?
- 11) For each foul beginning with the seventh team foul of each half, the offended team is entitled to free throws, either a one and one or a double bonus?
- 12) A1 shoots a jumper from just inside the three point arc. A2, while getting rebounding position, is called for a foul, this is an example of a team control foul?
- 13) A1 and A2 are in the front court. A1, while dribbling, goes around an illegal screen that is set by A2. A2 is called for a foul. This is an example of a team control foul? The penalty is that Team B is awarded the ball out of bound at the nearest spot to the foul?
- 14) Players A1 and B1 begin to fight and substitutes A6,A7 and A8 enter the court but do not become involved. Substitute B6 enters the floor and does not become involved. Ruling: A1, B1 & all subs that entered the floor are ejected. Team B is awarded a total of two free throws and the ball out of bounds at the division line opposite and each head coach is charged with one indirect technical foul?
- 15) Players A1 and B1 begin to fight, substitutes A6,A7 and A8 enter the court and do become involved. Substitute B6 enters the floor and does become involved. Ruling: A1 & B1 and all subs that entered the floor are ejected. Team B is awarded a total of four foul shots and the ball out of bounds at the division line opposite. Team A's head coach is charged with three indirect technical fouls and is ejected and Team B head coach is charged with one indirect technical foul.
